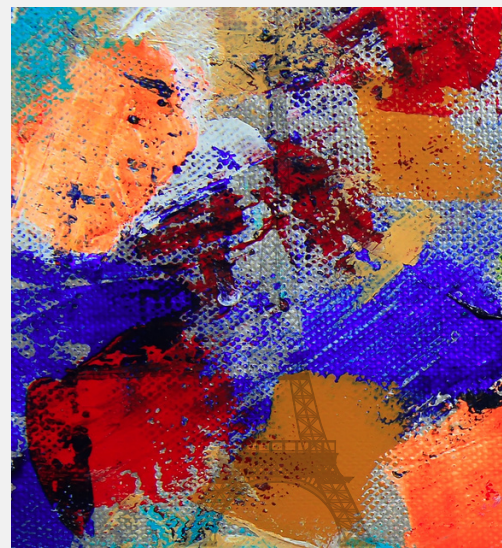

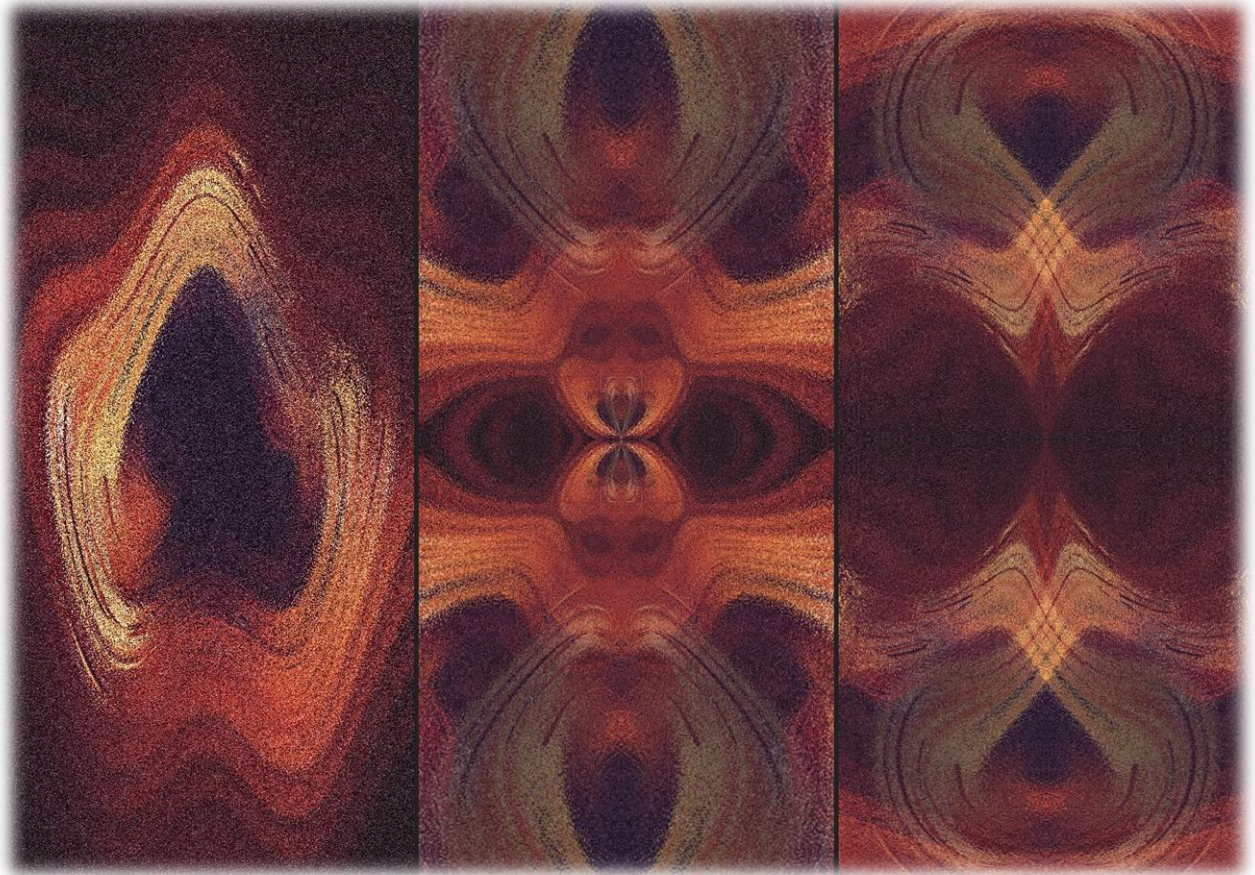

Kamuran KARAAĞAÇ



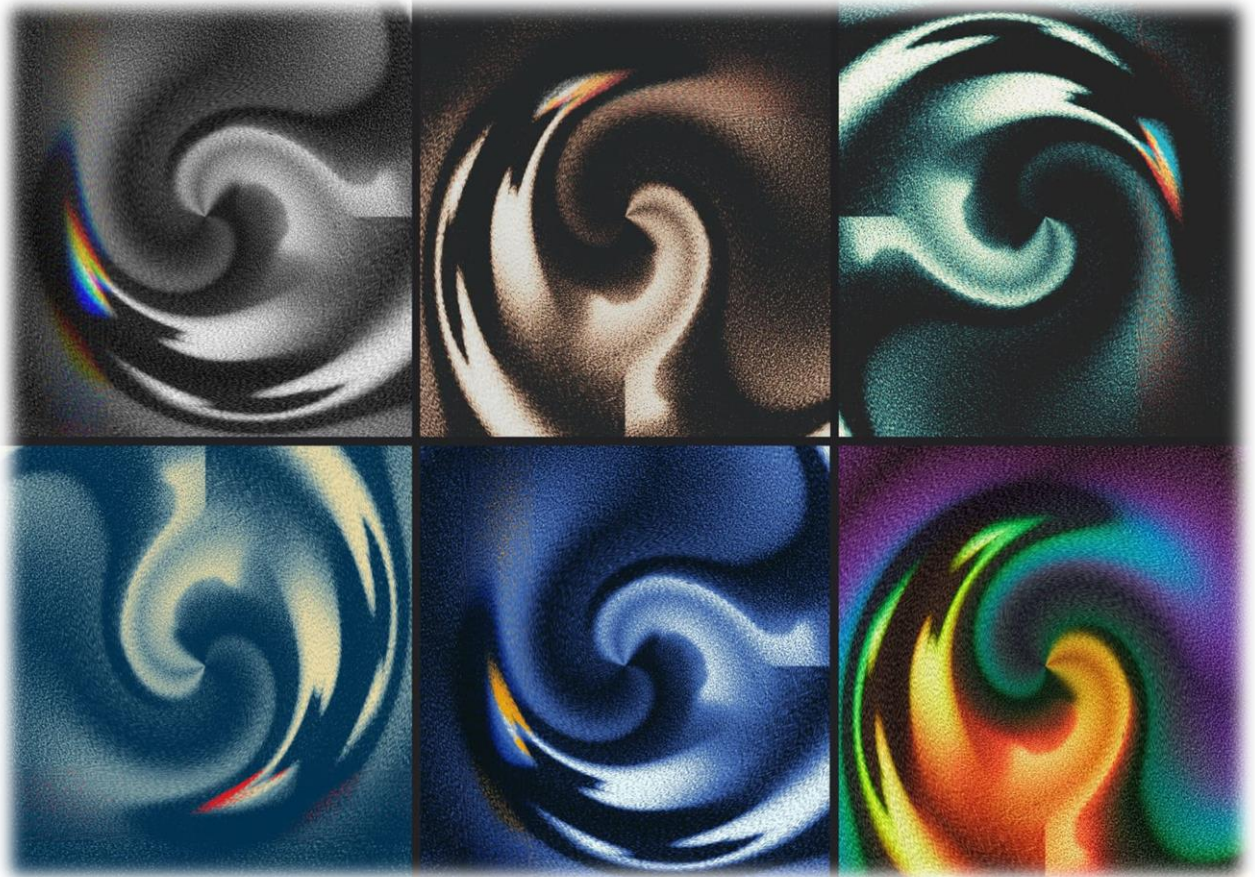

The photograph is a cross-section of a lonely scarecrow in a vast field landscape and a wooden fence, separate from it, trying to establish a closer connection with the viewer. The sense of distance and separation offers the viewer a depth of contact, while the distance between the railing and the fence stands out as a tangible indicator of loneliness. The black and white tones create an emotional atmosphere of loneliness, while the elements disappearing into the landscape offer a thought-provoking experience of the inner loneliness of people.

The Clean Ocean

Roughly eight million tons of plastic enters the ocean every year. Ocean trash is one of the world's biggest pollution problems. The amount of plastic trash that flows into the oceans every year is expected to nearly triple by 2040 to 29 million metric tons. Demand for consumer goods sheathed in disposable, single-use plastic has soared as shoppers seek protection from the virus. Plastics pollution has a direct and deadly effect on wildlife. Thousands of seabirds and sea turtles, seals and other marine mammals are killed each year after ingesting plastic or getting entangled in it. Endangered wildlife like Hawaiian monk seals and Pacific loggerhead sea turtles are among nearly 700 species that eat and get caught in plastic litter. It's time to get at the root of this ocean crisis. Ocean trash is one of the world's biggest pollution problems.
